
Welcome to Amsterdam!

### Day 6: TUESDAY, JULY 9, 2024 MIDDELBURG, NETHERLANDS




### Day 7: WEDNESDAY, JULY 10, 2024 ROTTERDAM, NETHERLANDS




Day 9: FRIDAY, JULY 12, 2024 AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS
